SOME MASAI GIRAFFES
HAVE BLOCKY MARKINGS,
OTHERS HAVE JAGGED,
LEAF-SHAPED, OR
STAR-SHAPED MARKINGS

LIKE OTHER GIRAFFES,
MASAI GIRAFFES EAT
MOSTLY LEAVES AND
SHOOTS OF TREES
AND SHRUBS
